

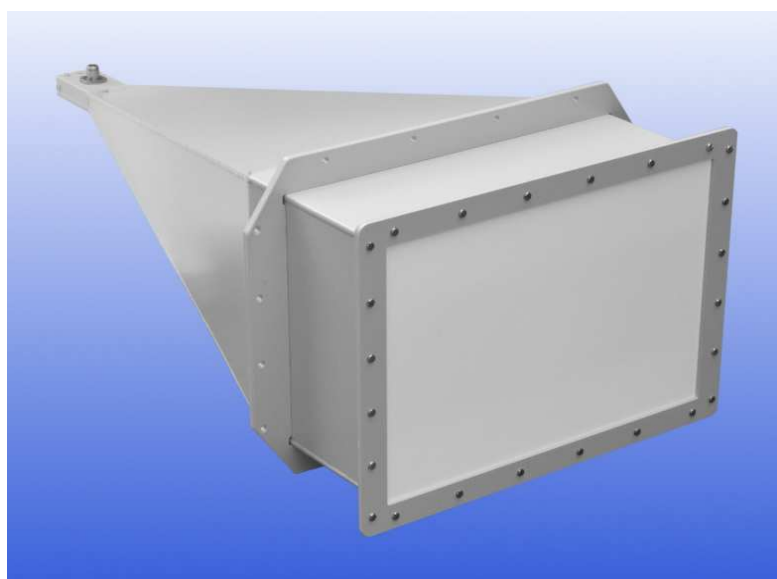

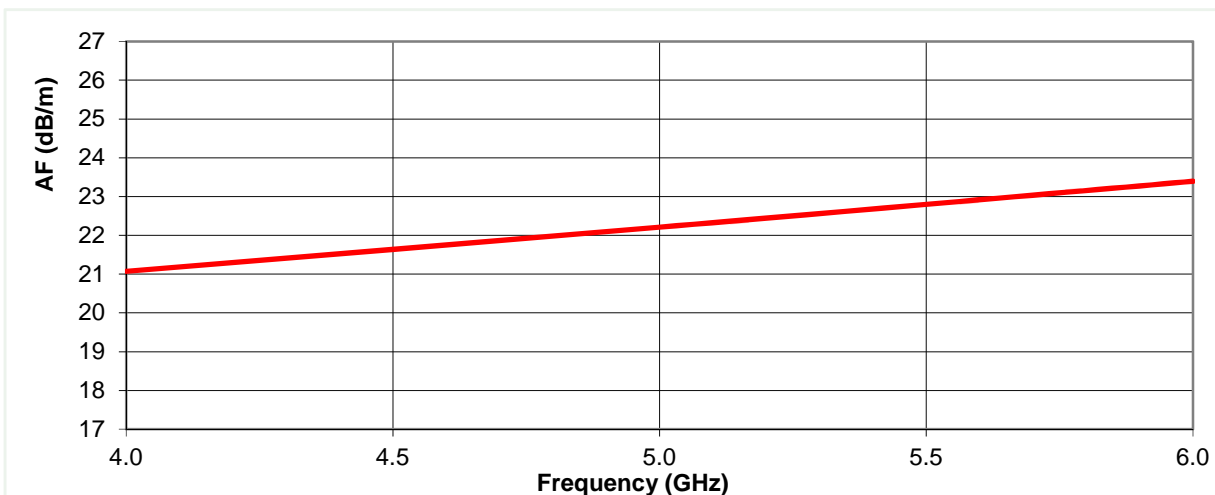
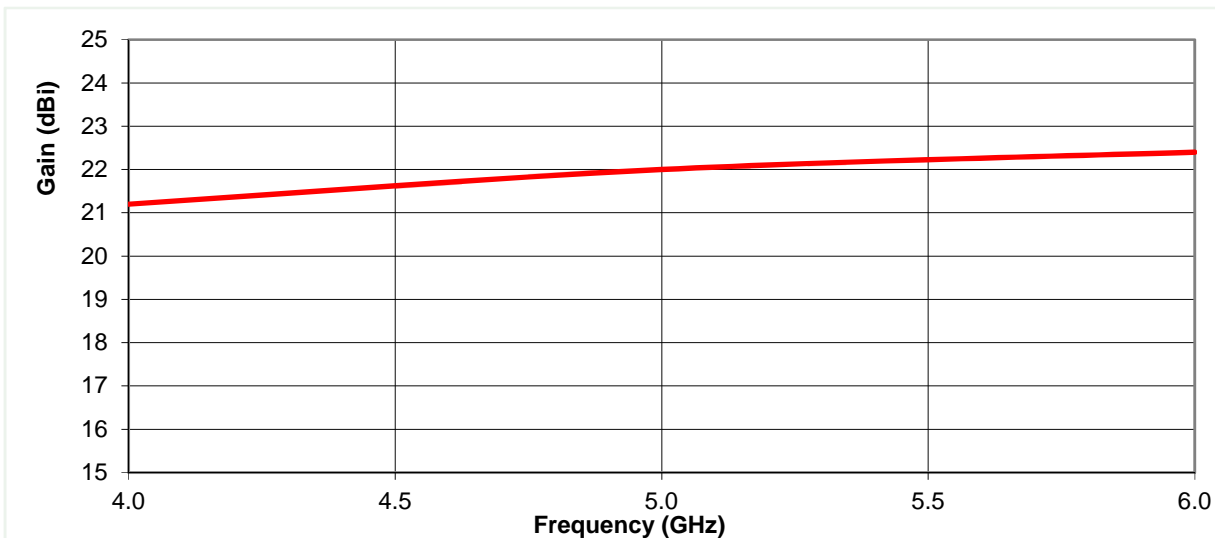

### Typical Specification

### Typical Antenna Gain / Factor at one metre

This is calculated by reference to standard gain horn antennas, and cross checked with reference to the antenna beamwidth, with an estimated error of +/- 0.8dB.



## 3dB Beamwidth at one metre

Estimated tolerance is  $\pm 2$  degrees
